
DISTRICT 3850

Our Vision:

Riding high on our rich diversity of cultures and languages, we are the Fun Rotary District serving communities in Southwest Philippines through Literacy, Health, and Disaster Response.

The Rotary International District 3850 covers 12 provinces in 7 islands of Southwestern Philippines. It is composed of 1200 Rotarians of 53 Rotary clubs coming from Iloilo City, Bacolod City, Zamboanga City and the 12 provinces of Aklan, Antique, Basilan, Cadiz, Guimaras, Iloilo, Misamis Occidental, Negros Occidental, Tawi-Tawi, Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga del Sur and Zamboanga Sibugay.



The District is one of the only two Districts in the Philippines that was accredited by Rotary International to conduct and host Youth Rotary Exchange Programs (ROTEX). To date, district has partnered with the districts in various countries like the USA. Canada. Brazil, Australia, Switzerland, Germany, Belgium and France.

• In RY 2016-17, the District is the implementor of 17 approved Global Grants in the cumulative amount of

- \$1,047,721.00 in various areas of focus, in particular, 8 projects in Economic and Community development, 5 in Disease prevention and treatment, 3 in maternal and child health, and 1 in Basic Education and Literacy.
- The District has a Disaster Response Team supported by all its Rotary Clubs funded by an additional assessment collected together with the governor's fund. This is aimed at addressing immediate, urgent needs of affected Districts, whether it be District 3850 itself or other Rotary Districts, during calamities and other emergency situations.
