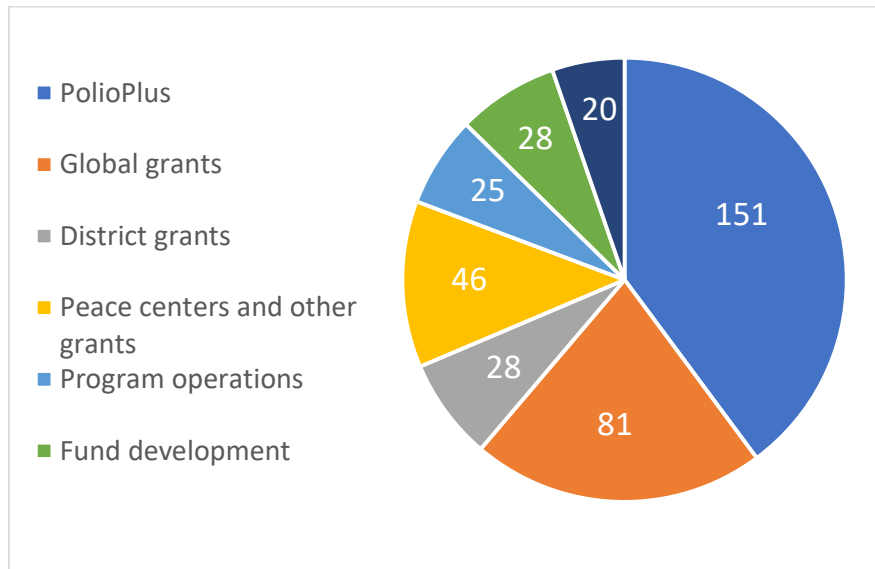


## Results of the Rotary Foundation (TRF) 2024-2025

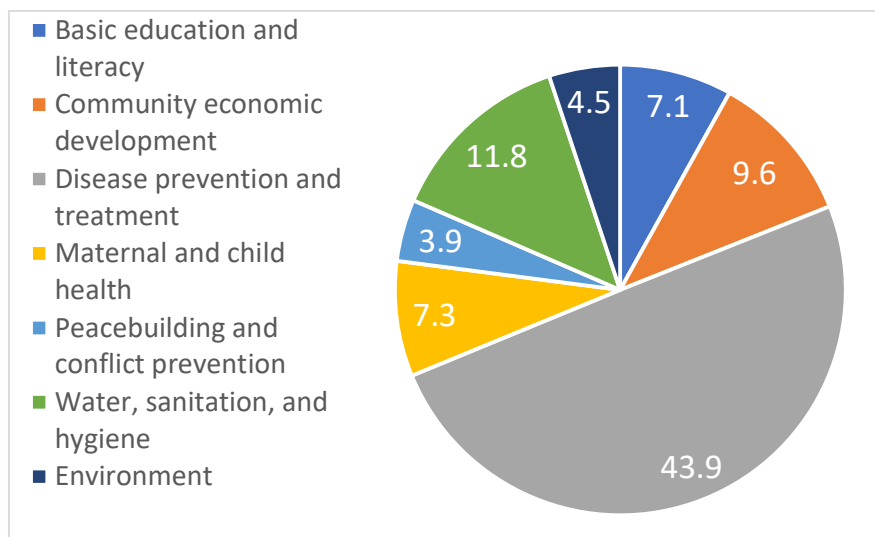
The total amount of donations to TRF funds was \$406.5 million:

Annual Fund - SHARE	\$146.4 million
PolioPlus Fund	\$132.8 million
Endowment Fund	\$64.0 million
Other contributions	\$63.3 million

Expenses of TRF constituted \$379 million; split of expenses was as follows:

## In Rotary year 2024-2025 TRF issued

- 468 District Grants, \$29 million program awards
- 1,423 Global Grants, \$88.2 million program awards
- 74 Disaster Response Grants, \$1.9 million program awards
- 1 Programs of Scale Grant, \$2 million program awards

## Return on Investments

**Annual Fund -SHARE** is the primary source of funds that support The Rotary Foundation's programs and Areas of Focus. Contributions to the Annual Fund are invested for three years. To balance risk and return, the Annual Fund portfolio is invested with an emphasis on income and capital preservation. The Annual Fund earned **6.9%** in Rotary year 2024-25.

The investments of contributions to **Polio Plus Fund** are limited to short-term fixed-income securities because the Foundation is raising and disbursing funds within a short time frame as we get closer to reaching our goal. Last year return on investments of PolioPlus Fund was **4.7%**.

The objective of the **Endowment** is to provide a permanent and sustainable source of funding. The Endowment aims to achieve higher long-term returns than the Annual Fund. Last year Endowment earned **12.7%**.

## Donations of Rotary clubs in our district 2405

If every Rotarian in our district would contribute **only \$20 per year** to the Annual Fund – SHARE and same amount to the Polio Plus Fund, the total amount of our contributions would be **\$50,000** for each of both funds. Unfortunately, until end of April 2026, **23 of our clubs have not donated at all**.

Only 23 clubs have donated to the Annual Fund, in total **\$14,012**, and only 5 clubs donated more than \$20 per member:

Three years later our district will have 50% of the donated amount available for our District Grants and Global Grants. The district will have very low amounts of grants available to support club projects. There is still time until the end of this Rotary year while **we can change this**.

Total donations from 39 clubs to the Polio Plus Fund reached higher amount, **\$28,340**. Thirteen clubs reached the level of donations above \$20 per member:

District Project Fund started its operations in April 2026. The first 3 projects have been approved:

The remaining balance reserved for 2025-2026 project grants is 33,004 SEK. Every club of our district who has contributed to the Project Fund is eligible to apply for Project Fund grant. Applications are reviewed by the Board of the Project Fund in order of submission until the annual balance reserved for Project Fund grants is spent.
